



## Strengthening Your City's Resilience to a Disaster

Is your City prepared for a disaster? Are you prepared to handle a chaotic environment? Do you know where to find the resources you need to handle a disaster? Being prepared for a disaster is crucial in responding, mitigating, and recovering from a disaster. This course provides information on the planning and management of a large scale emergency or disaster in your community. The program will focus on National Incident Management System (NIMS) principles including such topics as disaster preparedness, response, and recovery. The session will include interactive discussion and a scenario-based table top exercise. The course will invoke your critical thinking and provide you practical information that can be used to prepare for a disaster.

The program will be presented by Ted Martin, Fire Chief and Emergency Management Director and Ben Bonner, Division Chief of Operations and Emergency Management Assistant for the City of Branson, Missouri. Chief Martin has led initiatives for organizational preparedness and response and recovery of several disasters in the City including tornado and flooding. Division Chief Bonner has a passion for teaching NIMS courses and has applied his knowledge through leadership and responses with a Missouri Incident Support Team, including a deployment to Hawaii's Kilauea Volcano eruption and Hurricane Lane.
